CLASSICO RISERVA 2015

SOIL

Alluvial origin, with fine and gravelly sediment, limestone.

WINEMAKING

The grapes are harvested by hand and laid down to dry in crates inside the drying loft for about 3 months where they lose about 25-30% of their weight and substances in the grapes become concentrated. After crushing, fermentation is started in stainless steel tanks for about 1 month at a controlled temperature. Continuous punching down by hand is carried out to favour the extraction of colour and structure. Afterwards, approximately 70% of the wine is transferred to French oak and Italian cherry barriques with the remaining placed in tonneaux where malolactic fermentation takes place. After ageing for about 24 months in wood, the wine is racked into steel tanks and then bottled.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE

Beautiful deep red colour, it presents full to the nose, with aromas of wild berries, blackberry jam and spicy notes that recall cocoa and toasting. Rich in the mouth, warm and soft, with tannins already quite mature and silky, well-balance and persistent.

HARVEST / 2015

A year characterized by extremely high temperatures and low rainfall during the growing season, factors that contributed to protecting the vines from pathogens. The high temperatures of July and August did not slow down the maturation of the grapes, which occurred earlier than usual.
